CRIME ALERT – Gunshots

The Metropolitan Police Department (MPD) is actively investigating reports of gunshots near Howard University's main campus.

This morning at approximately 1:14 a.m., it was reported that six (6) gunshots were fired in the 2000 Block of Georgia Avenue, NW, near Georgia and Florida Avenues. Shortly thereafter, it was learned from MPD that the suspect who fired the shots fled in a dark-colored vehicle (make and model unknown) and was last seen traveling northbound on 9th Street, NW.

At the time of this notification, there have been no injuries reported and the suspect, whose physical description is currently unavailable, has not been captured. This information was obtained from an MPD radio that is closely monitored by the Howard University Department of Public Safety (DPS).

Anyone who has knowledge of this incident should immediately contact DPS at 202-806-1100, or call 911 to reach MPD.
