CRIME ALERT – Shooting

The Metropolitan Police Department (MPD) is actively investigating a shooting that occurred this morning at approximately 12:20 a.m. in the area of 4th and W Street, NW, near Howard University's College Hall South residence hall. It was reported that two male victims, whose condition is unknown at this time, suffered gunshot wounds. The victims have been transported to Howard University Hospital.

At this early stage of the investigation, only a brief description of the suspect can be provided. The suspect is described as a Black male, wearing all dark-colored clothing. It also appears that the suspect and the victims are unaffiliated with Howard University however, the MPD investigation is ongoing.
