CRIME ALERT – Stabbing

The Metropolitan Police Department (MPD) is actively investigating a stabbing that occurred this morning at 4:15 a.m. at Georgia Avenue and Bryant Street, NW.

A lookout has been issued for two Black males. The first suspect has a slim build and a light complexion, approximately 5'9 to 5'10 in height and wearing a white shirt. The second suspect has a dark complexion, approximately 6'2, 250 pounds, and also wearing a white shirt. They were both last seen traveling south on Georgia Avenue. No further descriptions or details have been provided at this time, but the investigation is ongoing.
