CRIME ALERT – Robbery Snatch

Howard University's Department of Public Safety (DPS) and the Metropolitan Police Department (MPD) are actively investigating a robbery snatch that occurred this evening at approximately 5:15 p.m. at the Starbucks located at Georgia Avenue near Bryant Street, NW.

It was reported that a Black male suspect approached the complainant, who is a Howard University student, and snatched her laptop from the table where she was sitting. The suspect fled the scene and entered a white Honda, which was last seen headed east on Bryant Street. No injuries were sustained during the incident.

A lookout has been issued for a Black male with a slim build and a gold tooth, and wearing blue jeans and a grey hooded sweatshirt. No further descriptions or details have been provided thus far, however, the investigation is ongoing.
