CRIME ALERT – Shooting

The Metropolitan Police Department (MPD) is actively investigating a shooting that occurred this morning at approximately 3:05 a.m. in the East Towers parking lot.

It was reported by two complainants that as they approached their vehicle, which was parked in the East Towers parking lot, they observed two males breaking into their vehicle. As the complainants walked toward the subjects, the subjects fired several shots in the complainants' direction. There are no reported injuries, however, there was property damage. The parties involved are not Howard University affiliated.

A lookout has been issued for two Black males armed with a handgun. One of the subjects is described as 5'3" tall and having a light complexion. The second subject is described as having a light complexion and a short chubby build. They both fled the scene in a silver-colored SUV.
