CRIME ALERT – Shooting

The Metro Transit Police Department, along with the Metropolitan Police Department (MPD), is actively investigating a shooting that occurred at the Shaw-Howard U Metro station in the 1800 Block of 7th Street, NW.

This afternoon at approximately 1:08 p.m., an individual was shot while sitting on the platform at the Shaw-Howard U Metro station. The victim sustained a single gunshot wound to the lower part of his body. Two suspects were last seen running southbound on Georgia Avenue.

One of the suspects is identified as a Black male, approximately 16 years of age, approximately 5'6" tall and 125 pounds, wearing a white t-shirt and blue jeans. The second suspect is described as a Black male, wearing a black shirt with a white stripe on the front left shoulder and blue jeans. No further description of the suspects has been reported. This incident and the parties involved are unrelated to Howard University.
